


# HONSHU

## Description

Faithful to its journey connotation, Graphic Elements 3 by Armani/Casa invites to explore the Far East: the aura of Japanese islands, with their rich nature and millenary culture, was the source of inspiration for patterns and textures featured in this collection. Honshu, the largest of Japanese islands, is rich in typical traditions. Among those, the one of origami occupies a special place in local culture. The ancient art of folding paper is repropose through the design of never-ending paper ribbons, folding and intersecting each other on the whole surface of the wallcovering. The design is obtained through a print with matt inks in relief, contrasting with the background made of a metallic silver gauze on a non-woven base.
