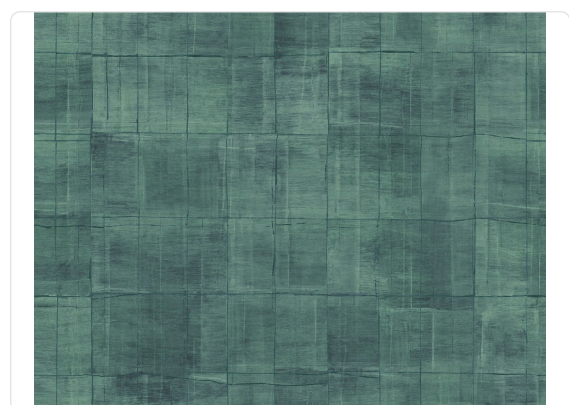

Collection GRAPHIC ELEMENTS 3

Description

Faithful to its journey connotation, Graphic Elements 3 by Armani/Casa invites to explore the Far East: the aura of Japanese islands, with their rich nature and millenary culture, was the source of inspiration for patterns and textures featured in this collection. One of the four major islands in the archipelago, Kyushu is considered the birthplace of Japanese culture. This wallcovering plays with three-dimensionality to recreate large enamelled tiles, in two versions emphasized by the use of particular techniques. The metallized version is obtained thanks to a 3D print on a non-woven base coupled with silver foil, which gives a satin effect to the final product; here, joints in between the tiles are matt. The second version, instead, has a shinier appearance thanks to a lacquer-effect print on a non-woven gauze, which emphasizes the grid.
